Saturday, March 18, 2017



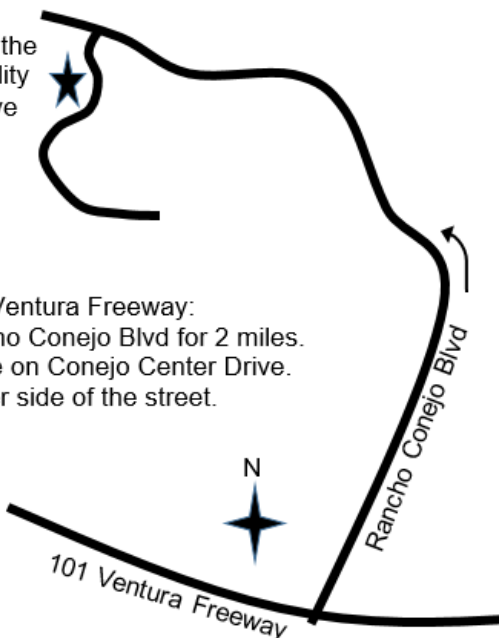
